Basic Skills Education program for unemployed Church members

This training is offered to selected members of Kganya at no charge. These include skills such as catering, sewing, bricklaying/plastering, carpentry, welding, and auto maintenance. Basic business management is provided during these courses which trainees can use to start up their own businesses or seek employment.

Pukwana ya Kganya Personal Accident


The personal accident benefit provides benefits for a member as a policyholder and their nominated dependants where such persons become permanently disabled.

The Evelyn Lekganyane Clinic

This is the only clinic in the area and supports people from Moria, Boyne and surrounding areas. An AIDS Outreach Programme also runs from here and meals are provided to affected community members.




2006

Kganya Crisis Management (Kganya Direct)

The main purpose of the product was to offer the main member – who has to be a ZCC member – the opportunity to have cover as follows for the main member, up to two spouses, 5 children, 4 extended family members, 2 parents, 2 parents in law and 4 extended children. The family other than the main member does not have to be a ZCC member. They were also allowed to choose the level of cover for each member insured.

This product later changed in 2016 to Kganya Mahlasedi.

Leeto la Moria

Established a discounted bus return ticket for qualifying Kganya members to Moria for the three pilgrimages, they also receive two free meals on the trip. This is on a first come first served basis.



2012

Pukwana ya Kganya Dread Disease

The personal accident and dread disease policy provides dread disease benefits when the member as policyholder suffers a dread disease.

Kganya Insurance Administrators


Merger of Kganya Administrators and Castellum Administrators into Kganya Insurance Administrators



2015

Lekgotla la Moruti Good Health Assessment

Launched health assessment screening for Church Committee members at certain pharmacies. This later included health assessment screening for Church Youth Committees and Moria staff.



2016

The Evelyn Lekganyane Clinic Extension

Extensions include a second block of staff houses consisting of four rooms and two kitchens, a second storey to the existing building made up of eight consulting rooms, a storage facility for the HIV/Aids feeding scheme, a strong room, two social worker rooms, a waiting room, restrooms, a lecture room and the first and only clinic with a mortuary (cold-room) and elevator in the province.

2023

Kganya Matshediso / Basic Needs Benefit

The benefit provides discretionary and temporary support to eligible Members who have biological children between the ages of 6 and 24 months.





Grade 12 Study Guides


The start of Kganya Educational Fund Trust handing out study guides to Grade 12 learners. The KEFT later became Kganya Projects.

Winter Skills Enrichment


A project for grade 11 & 12 learners with the aim of assisting learners to achieve their best academic grades in Mathematics, Physical Science and Commerce subjects.
